Location & Size: Nestled in the foothills of the Rocky Mountains, 24 students live on a 40 acre campus in the capital city of Helena, Montana.

Gender and Ages: All genders, ages 4-13 on admission.

Housing: 3 cottages with 8 children each. Private bedrooms. Intentional mix of ages and genders in each house.

Child Profile: Problems may include attachment and relationship issues, adoption issues, grief and loss, emotional dysregulation, intractable anger, mild aggression, depression, anxiety, impulsivity, poor social skills, high functioning autism spectrum, and IQ>85.

Clinical: Developmental Relational Treatment approach focuses on meeting the needs beneath complex behaviors. Individual, group, milieu, and family therapies provided.

Accredited Academics: On campus school. Certified teachers; small classroom size; core subjects as well as music, art, P.E., social skills, cultural studies, team sports, IPADs and SMART Boards. Speech & Language and Occupational therapy available.

Cost: Our published daily rate is \$900/day, which covers Family, Individual, Group Therapies, milieu therapy, education and therapeutic support during the school day, recreation, and activities. Our daily treatment rate does not include psychiatric assessments, doctor, and medications, dental, vision and travel, Speech, Language or Occupational therapies. We offer families an underinsured/uninsured discounted rate of \$500/day. There is also an enrollment fee of \$2,500 and months deposit due on admission.
